PROJECT REVISIONS / CLARAIFICATIONS:

- 1. Sealed bids will be received until 10:55 a.m. on July 9.
- 2. Use Revised Bid Form 5.1. Bid items for End Section and Mitered End Sections have been removed. All End Sections for roadway pipes and off site drainage pipes (does not include driveway pipes) shall have Mitered End Sections and shall be paid as L.F. installed CMP.
- 3. Section 1020 Corrugated Metal Pipe All pipe shall be annular riveted. All pipes sizes 30" to 36" shall be made of 14 gauge material.
- 4. Driveway @ STA 6+39L is a gravel driveway and not a concrete driveway.
- 5. Driveway aprons shall be full depth as per roadway cross-section.
- 6. Alternate A Bid If accepted, the 36" CMP pipes to be removed shall be made available for pick-up by Boone County Public Works. Contractor will be responsible for loading on BCPW trailer. If pipes become damaged and unusable, contractor will be responsible for disposal. A minimum of 48 hours notice will be required for pickup of salvaged pipes.
- 7. Driveway @ STA 92+22R shall be re-located to 91+19R.
- 8. Concrete Detail over CMP, page 9. Concrete shall only be used when a minimum of 6" of cover cannot be obtained.
- Contractor will be responsible of coordinating all activities with Panhandle Eastern Gas Company and Norfolk Southern Railroad. Pay close attention to the Technical Specifications Section 105 and the Special Provisions for Protection of Railway Interest.
