

## BOONE COUNTY, MISSOURI Request for Bid #: 47-11SEP08 – Autumn Drive Drainage Improvements

## **CLARIFICATION** - Issued September 10, 2008

This addendum is issued in accordance with the Bid General Specifications of the Request for Bid and is hereby incorporated into and made a part of the Request for Bid Documents. Offerors are reminded that receipt of this Clarification SHOULD be acknowledged and submitted with Offeror's *Response Form*.

## I. Page 14.1 section 2.2 of the General Specifications states:

**Proposal Guaranty**. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a proposal guaranty. The character and the amount of the proposal guaranty to be furnished by Bidders shall be stated in the proposal for each project. The proposal guaranty shall be executed by some surety company authorized to do business in the State of Missouri, as a guarantee on the part of the Bidder that if his bid be accepted, he will within ten days after receipt of notice of such acceptance, enter into a contract and furnish a contract bond to do the work advertised; and, in case of default, forfeit such proposal guaranty.

## Clarification:

If Bidder's total bid price exceeds \$25,000.00, the bid response shall be accompanied by a proposal guaranty equaling 5% of the total amount of the bid. The bond shall be executed by some surety company authorized to do business in the State of Missouri, as a guarantee on the part of the bidder that if his bid be accepted, he will within ten (10) days after receipt of notice of such acceptance, enter into a contract and furnish a Performance Bond/Labor and Material Payment Bond to do the work advertised; and, in case of default, forfeit such bid bond.
